Minutes of the Rosedale Parish Council meeting held on 13 October 2011

Apologies from Sue Austermuhle and Kate Jones were accepted by the Council.

O6160 Questions and statements from the public

No questions or statements were received.

o6161 Declarations of interest

No declarations were made.

o6162 Minutes of previous meeting

The minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 14 September were accepted as a

record and signed by the Chair.

o6163 Community Group update

No representative of the Community Group was present and no report had been received.

06164 Matters arising - Highways issues

The Council heard that a date for resurfacing Gill Lane had been rescheduled, but that

Highways had agreed not to do it during half-term.

The Council heard that its request for two roads to be upgraded for priority for gritting had

been turned down.

The Clerk informed the Council that it was allowed to spend money on a road mirror, but he

was still waiting to hear from the National Parks Authority and the Highways Department on

whether permission would be needed.

o6165 Matters arising - Village clock

The Clerk said that he had contacted North Yorkshire County Council and was waiting for a

response.

o6166 Matters arising - Broadband

The Clerk said that he had written again to BT and was waiting for a reply.

o6167 Matters arising - Hydro project

The Clerk said that he had invited a representative from Esk Valley Energy to the

November

meeting, and was waiting for a response.

o6168 Highways issues

Councillor Scarth reported that there had been complaints about the state of the road at

Heygate Bank.

Resolved: To contact Highways about this, and contact Councillor Val Arnold if no satisfactory reply is received.

Councillor Storey also reported that a drain had been blocked on Thorgill Road since November as a result of unfinished work by BT.

Resolved: To complain to BT about this, and report the matter to Highways.

o6169 Community noticeboard

Resolved: That the Vice Chair would look at this board with the Village Caretaker, and

report back.

06170 Bus shelter

The Council heard that they had not yet received the details from the Community Group.

O6170 Dog fouling

The Council heard that the new dog waste bin was ready to be delivered to the Village Caretaker, and that the Clerk still intended to circulate information on dog fouling to Councillors so they could form a policy.

Resolved: To contact the landowner to ensure there was no objection to installing the bin.

06171 Village Caretaker's queries

The Council heard that the Caretaker was concerned about the state of some of the memorial benches in the dale and wanted to know who owned them and who was responsible for their upkeep, and also that he wanted somewhere to place compost bins as a

community resource.

Resolved: To contact the National Parks Authority to find out what to do about the memorial benches;

That the Vice Chair would liaise with the Caretaker to discuss the compost situation.

o6172 Emergency Planning Training

Councillor Gage reported back from this session, and said that she would like to discuss an

Emergency Plan for Rosedale.

Resolved: To invite someone from the North Yorkshire County Council Emergency Planning Unit to address the Parish Council.

O6173 Passing place at Brick Cottage

The Council heard that this was not a legal passing place and that NYCC could therefore not enforce it.

Resolved: To write to the owner asking if they could park so that larger vehicles would

find it easier to pass.

Minutes on noticeboards

Resolved: That Councillor Storey can place signed minutes on the Thorgill noticeboard,

in view of the Clerk's difficulties of access.

06175 Newsletter forwarding

Councillor Storey clarified that it was acceptable to send newsletters by e-mail to anyone that

requests them, even from outside the dale.

Resolved: That the Clerk will send newsletters by e-mail to whoever wants them

o6176 Southern Area Parish Forum meeting 8 November 2011 The Chair and Councillor Scarth said that they would attend this meeting.

Resolved: To place the issues of the memorial benches and mobile coverage in emergencies on the agenda for this meeting.

O6177 Parish Liaison meeting 26 October 2011

The Chair and Councillor Scarth said that they would attend this meeting.

O6178 Proposed Definitive Map Modification Order Rosedale East Footpath O27 Hillside Cottages, Daleside Road YO18 8RG The Council raised no objection to this modification.

o6179 Future Council meeting dates

The dates for next year's meeting were agreed as the second Thursday of each month, except for 8 August.

o6180 Finance

As the Caretaker's timesheets were not available, it was agreed to raise a cheque outside of

the meeting and report back.

Cheques were paid for the Clerk's net salary and expenses (£498.77) and tax (£121.82).

The Council noted receipt of the second half of the precept (£2035).

Cheques were signed to the Yorkshire Local Councils Associations for an updated set of

standing orders (£27), to the Reading Room (£250) and for the Royal British Legion for a

memorial wreath (£40).

o6181 Any other business

Councillor Gage noted that the Supermobile would be visiting Rosedale on 31 October at

17:30 and every two weeks afterwards, and asked for this to be put in the newsletter. She

also asked for the winter gritting service to be placed on the next agenda.

Councillor Scarth said that Ron Foster was interested in the hydroelectric project and would

be happy to address the Council.
