07005. Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs Brown, Storey and Wilkinson

07006. Cllrs Dents declared a non fiduciary interest on item 07009 a)

07007. Minutes and Matters arising:

- a) The minutes of the Meeting held on 13 August 2015 were approved
- b) There were no matters arising from the meeting 13 August 2015 not covered elsewhere on the agenda
- 07008 No members of the public were present
- 07009 Planning; Council considered planning applications from NYCC and NYMNPA since the previous meeting
 - a) NYM/2015/0600/FL installation of replacement double glazed powder coated aluminium windows, replacement slate roof with solar panels together with replacement sewage treatment plant and erection of greenhouse The Orange Tree, Daleside Road, Rosedale East

The Council has no objections to the planning application.

The Council noted that a spring water supply is in existence in the near vicinity and should be protected against ingress from excavations

b) NYM/2015/0545/LB Listed Building consent for construction of two storey rear extension and single storey utility room (revised scheme to NYM/2014/0656/LB) Woodlands Farm Rosedale Abbey

The Council has no objections to the planning application

C NYM/2015/0543/FL construction of two storey rear extension and single storey utility room (revised scheme to NYM/2014/0649/FL) Woodlands Farm Rosedale Abbey

The Council has no objections to the panning application

07010 The Council noted that no decisions have been made by NYCC and NYMNPA regarding planning applications in the Parish since the last meeting and there were no ongoing applications awaiting decision

07011 Village

 a) Cllr E Dent reported that Cllrs E Dent and Brown have not yet met with the Caretaker to discuss the ongoing works required. Council noted that the tender document is due for review and request that the Clerk submit a revised document for consideration

- b) The Clerk reported that she has started to receive information regarding benches and general fixed assets this afternoon and will use this information to construct a risk assessment as required by the insurers
- c) Council received information in respect of the meeting held with NYMNPA
 Representatives and associated parties in Rosedale at the field to discuss the Car
 Parking proposal. The main issued recognised were the access to the possible car park
 and tree root disturbance.

The visibility splay was to be investigated and a tree survey is to take place.

A future meeting to take place on 17 September 2015.

The Clerk reported that Richard Marr had now verified that the visibility splays were passed subject to the hedges and fence lines being investigated.

d) Cllr E Dent reported that a member of the public had reported that "The Pond" has failed. Council noted that this was a "mill race" and not a specific pond. The Council noted that work done on this must ensure that should excessive rain occur run offs are unaffected.

The Caretaker is to be asked to prune it back to investigate the state of repair. The Parish Council confirmed that the upkeep of the rechristened pond is not the responsibility of the Council. The Clerk was asked to investigate the ownership of the land area near the kissing gate.

The Village Hall signs have still not been processed and further chasing of NYCC will take place.
